


In our prior decision in this matter we found that this student had taken up residence in North Kingstown. This finding negated the force of the proof of the school committee to the effect that this student had been living in an adjoining town. The school committee has now presented further evidence to show that this student is, in fact, still not living in North Kingstown. This proof consists of numerous observations made by the North Kingstown attendance officer. Some of this proof is directly supported by videotape. We are therefore forced to the conclusion that this student is not a resident of North Kingstown for school purposes.

CONCLUSION

This student is not a resident of North Kingstown for school purposes. North Kingstown is ordered to contact the adjoining school district to effect an orderly transfer of responsibility for this students education.
